As a condition of this sanction, UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION agrees to comply with and to enforce all COVID-19 health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, the State of North Carolina, local jurisdictions in effect at the time of the meet. Further, the meet will be conducted in accordance with individual facility requirements as detailed in the UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION Meet Plan below. Meets conducted in violation of these requirements and safety plans are subject to having the sanction revoked and will not be issued sanctions for future meets during the COVID-19 sanctioning period.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK DISCLAIMER

UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION COVID-19 MEET PLAN

NCS FACE COVERING STATEMENT

Following new CDC recommendations and the North Carolina Governor's latest Executive Order issued May 14, 2021, North Carolina Swimming has revised guidance on the use of face coverings at USA Swimming activities as follows:

- North Carolina Swimming strongly recommends that partially vaccinated or unvaccinated individuals continue to wear face coverings and practice social distancing at all swimming activities.
- Other individuals are welcome to continue wearing face coverings for personal comfort.
- NCS clubs may require that participants wear face coverings and observe social distancing at meets that they host.
- NCS members are expected to comply with all COVID-19 safety guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, the State of North Carolina, local jurisdictions, aquatic facilities, and member clubs.

FACILITY and HOST TEAM REQUIREMENTS

UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION has discussed specific health and safety procedures with the venue management and agrees to abide by all County approved COVID-19 facility protocols in place at the time of meet. **Currently, Mecklenburg County is requiring that all people in attendance (coaches, officials, volunteers, spectators and athletes (when not in the water) wear face masks.** Further protocols will be sent to UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION 10 days prior to meet and all pertinent information will be communicated to participants at that time. Compliance with the most current guidelines from USA Swimming, North Carolina Swimming, CDC, State and Local jurisdictions will be maintained throughout the duration of the meet.

SPECTATOR LIMITATIONS and PROTOCOLS

"In-Person" spectator viewing may be allowed at the discretion of the Meet Director in consultation with the facility and based on the most updated COVID-19 procedures for Mecklenburg County and the State of North Carolina. Should guidelines in place at the time of the meet disallow spectators, spectators may not enter the facility. The meet will be live streamed and instructions for viewing will be published on the UANA website prior to the meet.

PARENTAL ACCESS

Parents needing access to their athlete during the meet in a closed-deck environment can contact their children directly via cellphone and arrange to meet in the main lobby. Should parents be unable to contact their child directly, they should ask the front desk to see the Meet Marshal. In case of an emergency, please contact the Meet Director.

FACILITY

The competition pool is an indoor 8-lane 50-meter competition pool with 2 bulkheads. Minimum depth is 6 feet at the scoreboard end and 15 feet the diving board end. The pool is equipped with eight, 9-foot-wide lanes with non-turbulent lane lines and Astral starting blocks which will be used for competition in accordance with USA Swimming diving depth guidelines. Colorado 6000 electronic/automatic timing system with a scoreboard will be utilized with touchpads and two (2) timers per lane each operating a watch and button. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software will be used. There is a separate 4-lane 25-yard warm pool which will be available for continuous warm up and warm down. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. Seating for 1000 people is available. There is ample parking within 100 yards of the facility Smoking is not permitted inside the building. Absolutely no glass bottles will be allowed on the pool deck. Only meet volunteers, USA Swimming registered athletes and current USA Swimming registered officials and coaches may be on deck.

MEET FORMAT

This is a prelim/final, short course meters format competition. The meet will be contested in an eight-lane format. Two courses may be utilized for preliminaries. Events/heats may be combined and official start times may be amended at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

RULES

This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and the rules of UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated.

TECHNICAL SUIT BAN FOR 12&US

Per USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F, 12 & Under athletes may not compete in Technical Suits at this meet.

A Technical Suit is one that has the following components:

- Any male or female suit with bonded or taped seams regardless of fabric or silhouette; or
- Any male or female suit with woven fabric extending to the knee or mid-thigh regardless of the seam type.

MAAPP

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Protection Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

SAFE SPORT

The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. Swimmers may be dropped off only in designated safe areas. Swimmers are not permitted in work out rooms, storage rooms, meeting rooms, or control rooms. No glass containers or bottles are allowed inside the facility at any time. Anyone failing to comply with a safety request may forfeit his or her privilege to participate. We strongly recommend each team assign a marshal to monitor warm-up sessions and locker rooms in addition to host team marshal.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the starting blocks. Flash photography of any kind is prohibited at the start of a race.

Deck changes are prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. It is also the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s guardian to request assignment from the Meet Director to a USA Swimming member coach attending the meet if a coach from the swimmer’s team is unable to attend.

Unless approved in writing in advance of the competition by the Program and Events Committee Chair or designee, operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Only swimmers, properly certified officials and coaches, and meet volunteers will be allowed on deck. ***No spectators will be allowed on deck at any time.***

**AIRPORT
TRANSPORTATION,
ACCOMODATION
AND MEALS**

All teams affiliated with a non-USA national federation must register to participate in the UANA Package in order to compete in the competitions (package is optional but encouraged for teams from the USA). To register, please complete and submit "UANA PACKAGE REGISTRATION FORM" that is included at the end of this document.

The UANA Package includes the following:

- Shuttle transportation from the airport to the hotel and return to the airport.
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner at the official hotel, competition venue or a local restaurant (location may vary by day/meal).
- Hotel accommodations for five nights at the official/designated hotel within walking distance from the competition venue.
- This package is valid from dinner on Wednesday, October 13, 2021, through breakfast on Monday, October 19, 2021.

UANA Package Pricing (total amount, Wednesday night through Monday morning):

1. US \$ 100.00 per person, per day, for **quadruple** occupancy room
2. US \$ 120.00 per person, per day, for **triple** occupancy room
3. US \$ 150.00 per person, per day, for **double** occupancy room
4. US \$240.00 per person, per day, for **single** occupancy room

Important Registration Dates for the UANA Package:

- Final reservation for the UANA package is **September 16, 2021**, after this date any federation **that has registered will be charged for the package.**
- Final Payment must be received by **October 1, 2021**; after this date any federation that **has not submitted their payment will no longer be able to receive** the benefits of the package **AND will not be allowed to participate in the competition.**

Each participating team is invited to include in its official delegation the following (not to exceed) number of Team Support Staff, at the same cost as the athletes and coaches:

1. Delegations with ten (10) competitors or less = Three (3) Team Support
2. Delegations with more than ten (10) competitors but less than twenty-five (25) = Four (4) Team Support
3. Delegations with more than twenty-five (25) competitors = Five (5) Team Support

Teams that are affiliated to a non-USA national federation are **NOT permitted to make their own arrangements for transportation to and from the airport, make their own hotel bookings, or coordinate their own meals if they wish to participate in the competition. Verification of participation in the package is required to participate in the competition.**

ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. and/or be registered with their home national federation. All athletes are solely responsible for ensuring compliance with this requirement. All Adult Athletes must hold current APT certification to compete, if a USA Swimming member. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. **There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.** The meet will be open to any athlete over the age of 12 years old who has obtained the qualifying standard to compete.

QUALIFICATION PERIOD

Qualifying swims must have occurred between March 1, 2019, and the entry deadline of September 16, 2021.

MEMBERS WITH DISABILITIES OR MEDICAL CONDITIONS

UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION's ability to accommodate all requests.

ENTRIES

Please email entries to SwimMeet.AR@gmail.com using Hy-Tek compatible software. All entries should be sent via email and must include the following:

1. A Hy-Tek compatible entry file (Free version of Team Manager 8.0 Lite available at <https://hytek.active.com/downloads.html>)
2. Team entry report (Hy-Tek)
3. Summary of Fees/Release Form (Found at the end of this document)
4. A list of Coaches attending the meet to confirm current credentials (Coach Deck Pass Request Form is attached below)

Alternately, an excel spreadsheet indicating Name, Last Name, Date of Birth (MM/DD/YY), event number, and entry time. **An extra admin fee of \$20.00 (twenty dollars) per athlete will be charged if entries submitted via excel.**

All entries shall be e-mailed to SwimMeet.AR@gmail.com no later than the entry deadline of September 16, 2021.

If you do not receive an email confirmation, your entries were not received.

All teams will pay via check, cash, or credit card to “**Union American de Natacion**” upon arrival to the meet; no payment by check in advance will be accepted. One check for the full amount due must be provided by team. Payment by credit card will be accepted with the addition of a 5% credit card processing fee to the total amount.

All entry fees and other amounts due and payable must be paid in United States Dollars before the start of your team’s first event.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS

Swimmers may enter ALL the events which they qualify for, however, they may only compete in a total of three (3) individual events per day and a total of eight (8) for the entire meet. If events are not scratched by the deadline, they will automatically be dropped at the point of over entry.

UANA and meet host reserve the possibility to allow international swimmers enter the meet even without qualifying standards if clearly able to prove to be considered to represent their countries at the 2021 Cali Junior Panamerican Games and/or 2021 Abu Dhabi FINA SCM World Championships.

BONUS EVENTS

- For 1 or 2 “A” Qualifying Times You Earn 3 Bonus Events
- For 3 or More “A” Qualifying Times You Earn 2 Bonus Events

Bonus events must be entered with a time as NT entries will not be accepted. **Bonus entries in the 400 FR, 400IM, and 1500 FR must have a qualifying time in one of those events.**

ENTRY VERIFICATION

An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Late entries may be accepted only with approval of the Meet Director and/or the Meet Referee. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING

ALL ENTRIES ARE TO BE SUBMITTED IN LCM FORMAT

Submit entry times according to the time swum – **DO NOT SUBMIT CONVERTED TIMES**. Non-conforming meter times will be seeded last according to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations 207.11.7B. All yard times, even if they are bonus event times, will be seeded for prelims slowest to fastest.

Prelims will be circle seeded and swum slowest to fastest alternating events by genders. Finals will be seeded according to the event order and swum as B final first, followed by A final.

Event #34 (Women’s 1500 Freestyle), as well as Event #19 (Men’s 1500 Freestyle) will be swum as a Timed Finals event, alternating heats of women and men, fastest to slowest.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE ARE NO CHANGES OR TIME UPDATES PERMITTED AFTER THE PSYCH SHEET IS PUBLISHED.

There is no positive check-in, except for the Women’s and Men’s 1500 Freestyle, Event #34 and 19. Please submit ALL other scratches by the daily deadline (see below).

CHECK-IN

All events will be pre-seeded and there will be no positive check-in except for the Women’s and Men’s 1500 Freestyle, Event #34 and 19.

SCRATCHES

Scratches prior to seed of preliminary heats shall be made by properly filling out/depositing a scratch card in the scratch box located at the Clerk of Course/Admin Referee table. **Scratch deadlines for Thursday’s events is at the conclusion of the coaches meeting, Friday’s events must be by Thursday evening at 6:00pm. For Saturday’s events, you must scratch by Friday at 6:00pm. Sunday’s events you must scratch by Saturday at 6:00pm.**

Finals: Any swimmer who competed in a preliminary heat and qualifies for finals must swim the event during finals unless the swimmer announces his/her intention to scratch from the event within 30 minutes of the announcement of the qualifiers for that event. He/she has until 30 minutes after his or her final prelim of the day to finalize his/her scratch with the clerk of course.

Any swimmer not reporting to a final event in which the results were posted for his/her swim must pay a \$150.00 fee to compete in his/her next event for not complying with the scratch rule UNLESS relieved for good cause by the Meet Referee.

SCORING

All scoring will be on a sixteen (16) place basis.

- Individual events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

AWARDS

Individual – Custom Medals for 1st through 3rd place
High Point: Open Men’s and Women’s
Team Awards: Combined Team, Top Men’s, Top Women’s
Performance Awards: Top Female and Male Performance (top FINA points performance)

RESULTS

Results will be posted on UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION website within 24 hours of the meet’s conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-Tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment. Unofficial results may also be published during the meet via Meet Mobile.

PROTESTS

All protests to the Referee’s decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the results of the event. The protest must be signed by the Delegation’s Representative and accompanied by \$100.00 USD in cash, check, or credit card. If the protest is upheld, the fee will be returned to the Delegation’s leader.

JURY OF APPEAL

The Jury of Appeal, comprising three disinterested persons, to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee’s rejection of a protest, will be selected from the UANA Commission members for the competition.

TIME TRIALS

Time Trials may be offered Thursday, Friday, and Saturday upon conclusion of the prelim sessions and are at the discretion of the Meet Referee. All Time Trial sessions will be held in SCM ONLY. Cost per event is \$30.00 USD (thirty dollars) payable by cash, check, or credit card. Sign up will be at the administrative table each morning.

Time trials must be registered before the deadline set by the Meet Referee but no later than 10:30am on the day on which the time trial is to be contested. Entrants in time trials must be entered in the meet. Each swimmer is limited to a maximum of two (2) time trials during the course of the competition. Time trials will count toward the swimmer’s individual event total for each day but not for the meet total.

COACHES

All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and/or their national federation. Meet Management will require all USA Swimming-registered coaches to show proof of such by prominently displaying their registration card or be prepared to show their Deck Pass virtual membership card upon request. Coaches from a national federation that is not within the United States of America must be prepared to prove good standing with that federation if requested by Meet Management. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee’s discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches’ meetings.

OFFICIALS/TIMERS/ VOLUNTEERS

UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION welcomes and encourages anyone willing to volunteer. Officials wishing to officiate at the meet should complete the online [Application to Officiate](#). Selected officials will be notified prior to the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming, or be listed on UANA SW Officials’ List 4, FINA Officials’ list SW 20, or FINA Officials’ list SW 21. Certification will be verified before the meet. There will be a meeting at the day(s)/time(s) listed in the “Deadline and Meeting Summary” above. Meetings may be in-person at the meet or virtual in advance and assignments may be communicated electronically prior to each session. All officials are strongly encouraged to complete an individual personal review of applicable USAS rules prior to the meet. Officials should report at the time specified by the Meet Referee and bring a mask (if necessary) and a writing utensil.

There will also be a need for timers and other volunteers for all sessions. Please contact the Meet Director by email MeetDirectorCLT@gmail.com with your availability to help.

HOSPITALITY/ CONCESSIONS

There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Refreshments may be available at the concession stand.

WARM-UP

In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-

up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down. **There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area.**

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Medical insurance is the responsibility of each athlete, coach, official, supporter, and National Federation representative. Neither UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION, FINA, nor USA Swimming, Inc. assume any responsibility for medical attention of the participants.

WAIVER/RELEASE

As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming. You acknowledge that you are familiar with the Safety Rules of USA Swimming, Inc. and North Carolina Swimming, Inc. regarding warm-up procedures and meet safety guidelines, and that you shall be responsible for the compliance of your swimmers with those rules during this meet. UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION, North Carolina Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., their agents, employees, and coaches shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of illness or injury to anyone during the conduct of this meet. You acknowledge that by entering this meet, you are granting permission for the names of any or all of your team's swimmers to be published on the internet in the form of Psych Sheets, Meet Results, or any other documents associated with the running of this meet.

IMAGE RELEASE

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION-approved photographer(s) and videographers and to allow the right to use names and pictures before, during, or after the meet such as in public psych sheets, heat sheets, and results or featured on the UNION AMERICANA DE NATACION or NCS website or social media or in public broadcast of the event via television or webcast. Parents and guardians of minor swimmers who do not wish their swimmers to participate in interviews or have individual pictures featured on any media should inform their team's head coach and the Meet Director prior to the meet.
