



## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

### **2018 GOODWILL SWIM MEET**

The selection of future Goodwill Squads will be based on achieving minimum qualifying times, which in turn will be based on median times achieved at previous Goodwill Swim Meets.

However, as this will be the first participation by Jamaica at the Goodwill Swim Meet, the proposed minimum qualifying times will be waived for this edition only and instead replaced by a selection based on the relative rankings achieved by swimmers in their respective events.

To be eligible to join the Goodwill Squad:

1. The swimmer must be a Jamaican Citizen and holder of a valid Jamaican Passport or have been a resident in Jamaica for at least twelve (12) months prior to the entry deadline of the meet.
2. The swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ at least eight (8) weeks prior to the competition.
3. The swimmer must NOT have competed at CARIFTA or higher (CCCAN, CAC etc.) regional or international swimming competitions in the same year as the Goodwill Meet.
4. The swimmer must have achieved at least two (2), top-2 rankings in events listed for their age-group on the Goodwill summons. LCM times will be used.
5. Rankings will be compiled from times achieved between October 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 and May 27<sup>th</sup> 2018.
6. Times must have been swum at meets sanctioned by the ASAJ or other FINA recognized bodies.
7. Swimmers being considered for selection must demonstrate fitness.
8. If there are more than four swimmers qualified for an age group using the abovementioned criteria, the four swimmers with the highest TUSS time standards will be selected.
