



SELECTION CRITERIA

BLP16.1.12 JUNIOR PAN AMERICAN GAMES

1. Final Selection must be ratified by the Jamaica Olympic Association.
2. Swimmer must be a Jamaican citizen.
3. Swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ no less than 5 months prior to the competition
4. Times swum within the time period stated by the Qualification Systems Manual will be considered.
5. Times must have been swum in a LCM meet sanctioned by the ASAJ or other FINA recognized body.
6. Swimmer must qualify in at least one (1) event.
7. Qualifying times: As established by UANA
8. If more swimmers achieve the qualifying standard than spaces on the team:
 - a. Swimmers achieving the 'A' standard will be selected; thereafter
 - b. All swims achieving the 'B' qualifying standard will be assigned FINA points and ranked in numerical order
 - c. The swimmer with the highest FINA points will be selected and move down the order until the available spaces in the team are filled
9. Universality Places: Only athletes who are approved by UANA to compete, are eligible for Universality Places.
 - a. In order to be considered for universality, an athlete must have achieved a 'B' Standard.
 - b. Two (2) Universality places per gender are available to each NOC, providing there is no swimmer with an OQT/'A' standard in that gender.
 - c. Where more than one swimmer per gender has achieved a 'B' standard, highest FINA points for each swimmer's top qualifying event will determine the selection and he/she will be eligible to compete in a maximum of three (3) individual events
