Additional Rules:

Officials:

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.
2. Minimum age for OPEN events: 10 years old
3. There will be positive check forty-five (45) minutes before the start of session for all events 400 M and above. Failure to show after positive check-in, the swimmer will either miss his/her next event or pay a fee of \$1,500/US\$15.
4. There will be no refund for swimmers who scratch any event
5. Deck entries will be allowed at the discretion of the Meet Director. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points nor be eligible for awards.
6. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.
7. Participating Clubs are responsible for providing a counter for the 800 m and 1500 m events
8. Relay cards are in duplicate, the original must be handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the lane time keeper at the beginning of the event. Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with AQUA rules.

Referees and Starters on the World Aquatics Swimming Lists no. 21 \& 22 and PAQ List no. 5 will officiate at each session.

> Marshalling: There will be no Marshalling Area for heats. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress. The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the Starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim. Protests All protests to the Referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of a disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J $\$ 2,000 /$ US $\$ 20.00$ Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

## Jury of Appeal

A. There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.
B. Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries.
C. The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 3 persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each Club.

## Awards and Points:

Every swimmer who achieves the following A/B standards in individual events by age group will be awarded points based on 2021-2024 time standards as follows:

| AAAA | AAA | AA | A | BB | B |

| 10 | 6 | 4 | 3 | 2 | 1 |

Points for relay teams will be awarded as follows: $18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2$ for 1 st to 8 th place, respectively.

Masters events results will be scored using the AQUA Masters Age Groups. The eight (8) fastest swimmers in each Masters Age Grouping will score points as follows: $9,7,6,5,4,3,2$, \& 1 . Masters points will not contribute to overall team scores.

There will be an Achievement Trophy for the male and female swimmers with the highest combined 'A' points in the following Age Groups: 8 \& Under, $9-10,11-12,13-14,15-16$, and $17 \&$ Over. Swimmers must score a minimum of 10 points to qualify for the Achievement Trophy.

Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all events by age group. A trophy will be awarded to the $1^{\text {st }}$ place Club in the Age Group competition and the 1st place Club in the Masters competition.
