## BLP16.1.2 CCCAN

1. Final selection must be ratified by the ASAJ Council.
2. Swimmer must be a Jamaica Citizen or resident in Jamaica no less than 12 months prior to the entry deadline of the meet.
3. Swimmer must be registered with the ASAJ a minimum of three weeks prior to the start of the local qualifying meet.
4. Times swum January 1 or after in the year of competition will be considered for $11-14$ swimmers. Meets that are not fully contained within the qualification period but fall on a boundary date will be included.
5. Times swum up to twelve months prior to the start of the competition will be considered for 15 \& over swimmers. Meets that are not fully contained within the qualification period but fall on a boundary date will be included.
6. Times must have been swum in a long course meet sanctioned by the ASAJ or other AQUA recognized body.
7. Swimmer must qualify in at least two (2) events.
8. Swimmer must be ranked in 1 st or 2 nd place in the event in which the standard is achieved.
9. Qualifying times:
a. Latest TUSS AAA time standards.
b. The 8th place median of the last three years in events where there are no TUSS
standards.
c. Tables with the time standards will be published by September 1 each year.
10. In the event that that only three(3) swimmers have automatically qualified in an age-group, a fourth swimmer (meeting the AAA qualifying criteria) will be selected to be part of a relay team whose combined times as determined by Hy-Tek would match or better the median $8^{\text {th }}$ place for the event over the last three (3) years.
11. Swimmers selected for Open Water will be allowed to swim pool events provided that they do not displace any qualified swimmer. An Open Water swimmer must have achieved the qualifying AAA time standard for 1500 m Freestyle and must be ranked 1st or 2nd in this event.
12. Automatic qualifiers will not have the first choice to swim individual events in which they have not qualified. The swimmer selected will be the highest ranked swimmer, even if that athlete happens to be one selected for relays or Open Water.
13. In the event that there are four (4) automatic qualifiers in a particular age-group, including a swimmer qualified for Open Water, an additional relay swimmer could be selected to be part of a relay team whose combined times as determined by Hy-Tek would match or better the median $8^{\text {th }}$ place for the event over the last three (3) years.
14. All relay teams will be selected based on a combination of swimmers that equals or betters the $8^{\text {th }}$ place median time of a relay event over the last three (3) years, irrespective of being automatic qualifiers to the CCCAN team. In the absence of any such combination, the automatic qualifiers will be selected to swim the relay event.
