Eligibility:	All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ. ONLY swimmers training locally will be allowed to compete. Limited to the first 100 swimmers per session. All Clubs who wish to enter must have representation. Where the number of entrants exceed 100, Clubs will be asked to reduce the number of swimmers they have entered.				
	Age groups according to the swimmer's age as at <b>December 31st, 2020.</b> Minimum Age of Entry: 9 years old				
<b>Registration:</b>	The ASAJ register closes May 28, 2021 at 4:00 pm				
Entry Fees:	N.B. ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE. J\$600 per swimmer per individual event Entry fees are to be paid before the meet. (This will be strictly enforced. Clubs that do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate). Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.				
Entry Limits:	Maximum number of events per swimmer per session – Three (3)

Programme:	All events will be swum in a timed final format.			
	The 800m and 1500M freestyle will be swum as a mixed event. Lanes 1-4 will be assigned to female swimmers, lanes 5-8 will be assigned to male swimmers			
Additional Rules:	Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the event. Deck entries will NOT be allowed. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the event. Time Trials will be accommodated at the end of the scheduled session, if time permits, and at the discretion of the Meet Referee. Cost: \$1,200 per time trial.			
Volunteers & Coaches:	Per Covid-19 Protocols.			
Marshalling:	There will be no Marshalling Area for the time trials. Swimmers are responsible for following all racing protocols. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after the second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.			
Scoring:	There will be no scoring in this time trial.			
	A timeline will be published 3 days before the competition.
