Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists No. 15 and 16 will work each session.

ENTRY DEADLINE: 4:00 PM on Wednesday, March 7th 2018. Manual entries are to be delivered to the ASAJ Office at the National Aquatic Centre, Independence Park, Kingston 5 or email to <u>asaj.meets@gmail.com</u>. **Coaches are required to indicate the names of swimmers, their Club, and the desired distance and stroke per swimmer.**

Note: TIME TRIAL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE START OF MEET.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Local clubs are required to submit, with their entries, a list of volunteers to act as Timekeepers to ensure the smooth running of the time trials. Clubs must submit the names of volunteers to the ASAJ Office on Thursday March 8th. Before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Clubs are expected to provide the following number of timekeepers (non-compliant clubs will be excluded from participation):
 - Two (2) for every swimmer entered

MARSHALLING

- 1. There will be no Marshalling area for the meet.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified.
- 3. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and he has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

ENTRIES

- 1. Deck entries will be allowed. A fee of JA\$700 per event will be charged.
- 2. Scratches must be presented thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the finals. Failure to comply will result in the following penalty: A fine of JA\$500 is to be paid immediately upon reporting the scratch. The Club will be denied further participation in the Time Trials if the fine is not paid
