Pool will be opened 60 minutes before the start of each session. All participants, athletes, coaches, officials must leave the pool facility at the end of the Saturday am session to facilitate cleaning

Eligibility: All Clubs and swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ. LIMITED TO 150 SWIMMERS per session. ALL CLUBS WHO WISH TO ENTER MUST HAVE REPRESENTATION. Where the number of entrants exceed 150, Clubs will be asked to reduce the number of swimmers they have entered.

Age groups according to the swimmer's age as of **December 31st, 2020.**
Minimum age of entry: 7 years old

Registration: **The ASAJ register closes at 4:00 pm November 12, 2021.**

Entry Fees: N.B. ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED VIA HY-TEK SOFTWARE. J\$400 per swimmer per individual event. Relays are \$800 per team.

Time trials are \$500 per event.

Entry fees are to be paid by November 18, 2021 by 4:00pm. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Clubs/swimmers who do not adhere to this will not be allowed to participate).

Entry Limits: **There is no limit on individual or relay entries. Points will be awarded to the top three individual finishers from each Club. Only 2 relay teams per Club will score.**

There will be a strict adherence to the time limits of each session. The Meet director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop/move events, add breaks in order to hold an efficient meet within the Government of Jamaica Curfew Guidelines.



There will be positive check in for the 400 M freestyle. There will no refund for swimmers who scratch any event.

Technical Meeting: There will be a Coaches' meeting via Zoom on November 19, 2021 at 7:00pm to inform coaches of timelines and other pertinent Meet information. It is the Coaches' responsibility to be aware of all changes.

Entry Deadline: Entries are to be submitted by **November 12, 2021 by 11:59 p.m.** to asaj.meets@gmail.com.

Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.

No late entries will be accepted.

Rules: FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition will apply. FINA Starting rule SW 4 will apply. Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified. See additional Rules and Regulations
Additional Rules in regards to Covid-19 Protocols are included in the Protocols document

Programme: All events will be swum as timed finals.

Additional Rules: Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition. Time trials will be allowed at the discretion of the meet director.

Deck entries will NOT be allowed. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.

OFFICIALS: Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists No. 20 & 21 will officiate at each session.

Volunteers: Per Covid-19 Protocols, one (1) chaperone per 20 swimmers will be assigned per Club who is responsible to ensure swimmers follow COVID-19 protocols. Officials and coaches as per Covid-19 Protocols.

Marshalling: There will be no Marshalling Area for the time trials. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after second



whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Scoring & Awards: Points for each individual event will be awarded as follows:

9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place

Points for relay will be doubled as follows:

18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place

Individual events will be scored in the following age categories

7-8; 9-10; 11-12; 13-14; 15-17; 18 & Over .

Where events allow for multiple age group to be combined, swimmers will score in their age groups

There will be no awards for individual events . There will be an announcement of overall team scoring, but no awards will be presented. There will be a certificate awarded to all swimmers who achieve a FINA time standard of 650 points or higher.

Relay Cards

Relay cards are in duplicate. The original must be handed to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes BEFORE the beginning of the session. The duplicate copy must be handed to the chief lane judge or head lane timekeeper prior to the start of the race. Swimmers must be named in the order of swimming on the card. Any change may be made up to three (3) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that on presentation of a medical certificate.

Protests

All protests to the Referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of a disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury of Appeal

There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.

Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries.

The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 3 persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each club.
