The pool will be opened one hour before each session for warm up. All participants, athletes, coaches, officials must leave the pool facility at the

end of the Saturday am session to facilitate cleaning.

Eligibility: All Clubs and Swimmers, in good standing, registered with the ASAJ or other

FINA affiliatedFederations.

AgeGroup ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2021. Masters ages for the meet shall be as of midnight December 31, 2022.

Registration: The ASAJ register closes at 4:00 p.m. July 1, 2022.

Entry Fees: J\$400 per swimmer per individual event. Relays are J\$800 per relay team

Surcharge: J\$500 per swimmer

Entry Limit: Individual Entries – Maximum four (4) per swimmer; Relays- Maximum three (3)

teams per Club per event

The Meet director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or

drop/move events, add breaks in order to hold an efficient meet As an Association (especially at the leadership level) it is important to abide by agreed rules and guidelines.

Deck Entry Fees: J\$1,000 per swimmer per individual event, if space is available on a first

comebasis. J\$1,600 per relay team, if space is available on a first come basis

Entry Deadline: Entries are to be emailed to <u>asaj.meets@gmail.com</u> by Thursday July 7, 2022

at 11:59 p.m. Entry fees must to be paid by 4:00pm July 12, 2022. (This will be strictly enforced. There will be no late fees. Clubs/swimmers who do not adhere to

this will not be allowed to participate).

No late entries will be accepted.

Date of birth for each swimmer must be included in the entry file.

Concession: Meals, drinks, fruits & snacks will be on sale during the meet

Programmes: Will be available on sale at the meet

Rules: FINA Rules and ASAJ By-Laws in force at the time of the competition

will apply. FINA Starting rule SW 4 will apply

Any swimmer starting before the starting signal has been given, shall be disqualified.

See additional Rules and Regulations

All events will be swum as timed finals

Additional Rules:

1. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age group. If competitors swim outside of their age group, the offending swimmer will be disqualified from the competition.

- 2. Substitutions will NOT be allowed. Offending swimmers will be disqualified from the competition.
- 3. Deck entries will be allowed. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points.
- 4. Masters Records will be credited according to the FINA Masters Age Grouping system
- 5. Relay cards are to be completed in duplicate with the original handed in to the Recorder thirty (30) minutes before the start of the first event of the Session; the copy must be handed to the head lane time keeper at the beginning of the event.

Any change must be made no later than four (4) events prior to the scheduled event number, after that only on the presentation of a valid medical certificate. The swimmers must be named in order of swimming in accordance with FINA rules.

- 6. The Mixed Relay Teams must comprise 2 females and 2 males from the same Age Group
- 7. Scratches are allowed at any time.
- 8. There will be NO time trials.

Officials: Referees and Starters on the FINA Swimming Lists no. 20 & 21 will officiate at each session.

Volunteers: Clubs are required to submit, with their entries, the name and contact information for ONE (1) volunteer per session to act as timekeepers. The list must be emailed to asaj.meets@gmail.com or be submitted to the ASAJ Office at least four (4) days before the

start of the competition.

Marshalling: There will be no Marshaling Area for the time trials. The next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.

The coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block.

It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned to him/her. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat then the swimmer will automatically be disqualified. Once the swimmers are under the starter's orders and they have taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. If this occurs, the swimmer will be disqualified and not allowed to swim.

Protests:

All protests to the referee's decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the announcement of the disqualification, signed by the Team Manager or Head Coach and accompanied by J\$1,500 or US\$12.00 Protest Fee. If the protest is upheld the fee will be returned to the Club.

Jury of Appeal:

There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.

Each Club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations will be submitted in writing along with the entries.

The Jury of Appeal shall comprise 3 persons drawn from the pool of nominees submitted by each Club.

Pre Competition Warm-up Rules:

In the 50m pool, in the interest of the swimmers safety, the rules outlined below will be observed during warm-up prior to the start of each session. There shall be NO DIVING IN CIRCLE SWIMMING LANES AND TURN PRACTICE LANES, entry to these lanes is to be feet first, from a sitting position. A Safety Marshal will ensure compliance.

In the 25m pool all lanes will be circle swimming, with feet first entry from a sitting position at all times.

Awards and Points:

11 & Over individual events will be placed and scored according to the Age Groups: 11-12, 13-14,15-17, 18 & Over.

10 & Under individual events will be placed and scored according to the Age Groups: 6 & Under,7-8, 9-10.

Open events will be placed and scored according to the Age Groups: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14,15-17, 18 & Over.

Masters will be placed and scored according to the Age Groups: 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, etc. **Masters points will not contribute to overall team scores.**

Points for each individual event by age group will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for 1st to 8th place, respectively.

Points for relay teams will be awarded as follows: 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 for 1st to 8th place, respectively.
