The OC will organize training sessions in both the main competition venue and the swimming pool starting on August 26th, 2024, in the afternoon.

Therefore, if your team is planning to arrive earlier than <u>August 26</u>, please contact the OC with your training plans and request so they can organize the training accordingly. COMPETITION

Technical Meeting

The technical meeting will take place at Albergue Olimpico German Rieckehoff on August 28, at 18:00. The meeting will be open to everyone with appropriate accreditation. Team Leaders, Coaches and Athletes from each Delegation must attend.

The PanAm Aquatics Open Water Swimming Committee Chairperson will lead the meeting, which will be conducted in English and, if required, with interpretation to Spanish. The Technical Officials meeting will take place immediately after the Technical Meeting.

Competition Venue

Playa de Ponce, Ponce, Puerto Rico. Located at Parque Pasivo Enrique González, Calle Bonaire, Ponce, PR 00716.







Weather Information

Weather data over the last 9 years reveals an average air temperature ranging between 28 – 33 degrees Celsius at the dates of the competitions, with clear blue skies, nil precipitation, and humidity 60%. The prevailing wind pattern is from East trade winds at average speeds of 14.4km/h. Expected sea surface temperatures are between 28 and 30 degrees Celsius.

Entry Rules

The PanAm Aquatics Age Group Open Water Swimming Championships are open to entries from competitors in good relation with their National Federations who are members of PanAm Aquatics (PAQ) or of invited World Aquatics (AQUA) member Federations.

The competitor must be a citizen, whether through birth or naturalization, of the country being represented, according to the World Aquatics <u>Competition-Regulations</u>, Part I, Number 3 - Sport Nationality.

Every participant in the Championship must be a member of a Club, Regional or National Team of a Federation duly constituted, affiliated, and in good standing with World Aquatics & PanAm Aquatics.

Each Federation may enter with National Teams, Regional Teams, or Clubs. Federations may fill their entry in each category with athletes from a variety of teams or clubs, if they wish. Each NF may enter an unlimited number of entries per event. Swimmers from a National Team will be limited to a maximum of 2 swimmers per age group per gender, totaling a maximum of 20 swimmers overall. NF must designate which swimmers are entered as a National Team member.

Entries will only be accepted from the Federation on behalf of all entries from their country. Entries submitted from a Regional Team or Club will not be accepted. All entries will compete as their Federation and not as a Regional Team or Club.

All relay participants must have been entered in the meet. Competitors can only participate in their own age group, except for the relays:

- A. 12-13 (2012 2011), both genders.
- B. 14-15 (2010 2009), both genders.
- C. 16-17 (2008 2007), both genders.
- D. 18-19 (2006 2005), both genders.
- E. 20-21 (2004 2003), both genders.



Competition Format

The competition of 5km, 7.5km and 10km swim will be organized on a 1,250m lap course (left shoulder turns). Swimmers must swim eight (8) laps for 10km, six (6) laps for 7.5km and four (4) laps for 5km. The competition of 3km and 3 x 1km mixed relay will be on a 1,000m lap course, left shoulder turn. Details of the final course will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

Events 1-2: 7.5K, Male and Female for 16-17 age group. Events 3-4: 5K, Male and Female for 14-15 age group. Events 5-6: 10K, Male and Female for 18-19 age group. Events 7-8: 10K, Male and Female for 20-21 age group. Events 9-10: 3K, Male and Female for 12-13 age group. Event 11, 3x1K Mixed Relays for open category (12-21).

In the relay, each team must enter three athletes. The order of athletes in each relay must be submitted to the Clerk of Course one hour before the start of the day. Any NF may put together a relay using swimmers from other NFs to fill out the relay. However, that relay will not be able to officially score or accumulate points for their NFs.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the first three swimmers in each event.

National Federation Points Award. A NF high point award will be presented to the National Federation winner in each age group (female & male) based on the total number of points scored by adding only individual points. The presentation will take place at the end of the meet.

PanAm Aquatics Cup Award. A NF high point award will be presented to the National Federation winner in all age groups (female & male) based on the total number of points scored by adding individual and relay points. The presentation will take place at the end of the meet.

Points scored will be awarded in the following order for the 16 first positions: **20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1**. Only the first two swimmers from a National Federation (National Team and/or Clubs) will be eligible to score.

Relays will double the individual points. Only the highest position of each National Federation (National Team and/or Clubs) will be eligible to score.

All competitors shall receive a certificate in recognition of their participation.



Timing and Scoring System

Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used for registration and competition results. Timing will be done using the Electronic Timing System.

Clothing and Equipment

Clothing and equipment used by athletes and other participants in the Championships must comply with the documents listed in the World Aquatics <u>Competition-Regulations</u>, Part I, Numbers 7-8, *Rules Applicable to all Aquatic Sports - Swimwear and Wearables and Advertising Identification*.

Anti-Doping

During the competition, anti-doping control tests may be conducted, according to the control rules established by World Aquatics.

Protests

Protests will be resolved under World Aquatics <u>Competition Regulations</u>, <u>Part I, Number 13</u>. Protests must be submitted to the Chief Referee in writing by the team leader, with a deposit of US\$ 200, within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event. All protests will be considered by the Chief Referee.

The commission, made up of the following persons present at the event: Executive Committee Liaison, OW Committee Chair, OW Committee Vice Chair and OW Committee Secretary, will consider appeals against decisions by the Chief Referee and give recommendations to the jury of appeal, whose decision will be final.

Jury of Appeal

For the Championships, the jury of appeal shall consist of a minimum of three persons and will be comprised of the PanAm Aquatics Executive Committee and PanAm Aquatics Honorary Members present and the World Aquatics Delegate (if present) with the PanAm Aquatics President or in her absence a PanAm Aquatics Vice-President and/or PanAm Aquatics Executive Liaison for Open Water Swimming as Chairperson.



A jury member will be allowed to speak, but not to vote, on a case in which the interest of his/her PanAm Aquatics Federation is involved. Technical Officials shall not be entitled to form part of the jury.

In case of urgency, the jury may vote on a matter even if it has not been possible to contact all members. The decision of the jury will be final.

Technical Officials

Qualified individuals may apply to Pan Am Aquatics to act as Technical Officials in Open Water Swimming. All technical officials are expected to cover their travel and accommodation expenses. DELEGATIONS

Registration

All National Federation registrations and sport entries must be done through the PanAm Aquatics General Management System (GMS). Each national NF must complete their registrations before the designated deadlines. In the interests of providing the Organizing Committee with optimal time to make hotel, meals, transportation, and other logistical arrangements, please submit your registration at your earliest convenience.

Team Officials (this only applies to National Teams)

NF with eight (8) competitors or less: up to five (5) team officials. NF with nine (9) to sixteen (16): up to seven (7) team officials.

Accreditation

The Organizing Committee will provide all Athletes and Team Officials with an official Accreditation card. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to carry their Accreditation Cards with them at all times and to show them upon request. Team managers will be required to present photographic identification for all team members in order to collect the Accreditation cards.



Entry Fee

1. Entry fee: US\$ 50.00 per athlete (one time).

2. Team Officials accreditation: US\$ 30.00 per official (one time).

Airport

Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport (SJU), Puerto Rico. One hour from the *Albergue Olimpico* and an hour and a half from Ponce. The Organizing Committee will provide airport transfers to and from the meet hotel upon arrival and departure.

Accommodation

Option A. Albergue Olímpico German Rieckehoff Village General Rooms for up to 12 people, USD \$90.00 per night with the 3 meals.

Option B. Melia Century Hotel 75 Calle Cristina, Ponce, PR 00730

Single Occupancy	US\$	195.00	per day and per person

The daily fee includes:

- 1. Transportation to and from the airport and host hotel upon arrival and departure.
- 2. Three meals daily starting with lunch on August 26, and ending with breakfast on September 1, 2024.
- 3. Hotel accommodations.
- 4. Daily transportation between the competition venue or training pool and the hotel.
- 5. The special competition daily fee listed below is limited to the official delegation and is dependent upon the down payment deadline, July 8, and final payment deadline August 5.

Hotels must be booked on or before July 1, with 50% down payment received by July 8, and the full balance received by August 5 to receive the competition rate secured for the Championships. After those dates, the OC will not be able to guarantee availability of rooms, and the rates will increase by 30%.



For those participants opting to stay in a different hotel or accommodations:

- 1. Each NF will be responsible for all transportation for your delegation to and from the airport as well as to and from the competition venue.
- 2. Each NF will be responsible for all meals for your delegation.
